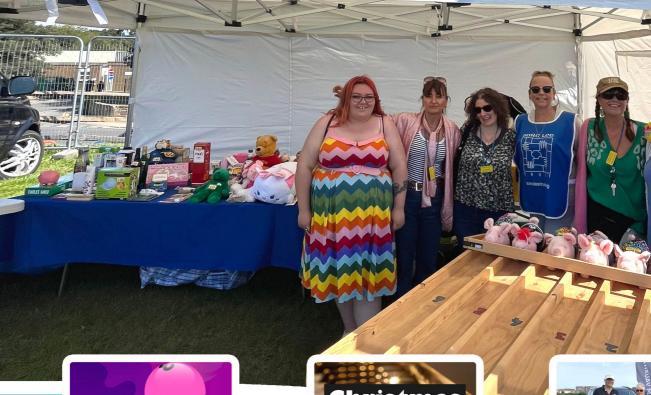

Tracey May of Heringtons Solicitors. Tracey heads the firm's

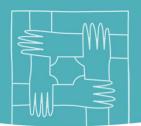
Vulnerable Client Services throughout their five East Sussex

#### Wellbeing Through Nature

Our Wellbeing Through Nature group is a 6 week programme held six times a year, combining group support and creative therapy with a nature focus for people with cancer and other life-threatening illnesses.

Participants are invited to slow down and enjoy tranquil surroundings, paying attention to the season's changes and their qualities. The group is sensitively facilitated to encourage sharing and personal reflection at our Therapy Centre in Sidley. There will be a short guided relaxation exercise and some breathing exercises. These are entirely optional and require no particular skill or previous experience.

#### Law Clinics

Working in partnership with Heringtons Solicitors, these regular clinics are aimed at improving the legal support and assistance available to local people with a new life threatening or cancer diagnosis.

Each clinic has a number of bookable appointments for a 30-minute consultation with an experienced Lawyer from Heringtons. Consultations must be booked in advance and are for Trust Service Users only.

### Mug Cake Recipe

Make a super easy cake in the microwave with less than 5 ingredients in 10 minutes for those days when you fancy something comforting but not too sweet. It can also be a sneaky way of getting your 5 a day by adding a little carrot, courgette, or beetroot.



#### **Ingredients**

- 3 tbsp Self-raising Flour (you can use gluten free)
- ¼ tsp Baking Soda or Baking Powder
- 1 1 ½ tbsp Sugar (white, brown or demerara)
- 2 tbsp Carrot (grated) or Courgette (grated) or Beetroot (cooked or raw)
- 3 tbsp Light Olive Oil
- 1 Egg, or 1 tbsp Chickpea Flour mixed with 6 tbsp Vegan Milk.

#### Method

- 1. Mix all the ingredients in a mug or cereal bowl
- 2. Sprinkle with nuts seeds or chocolate pieces
- 3. Bake on high in the microwave for 3 to 4 minutes
- 4. Share or not.



#### Extras to add

- · Cinnamon can help regulate sugar levels
- 1 tbsp Cocoa Powder, Pieces of Dark Chocolate
- 1/4 tsp Mixed spice, Vanilla essence, Cardamom
- · Dried Fruit
- Fresh Fruit
- · Nuts or Seeds

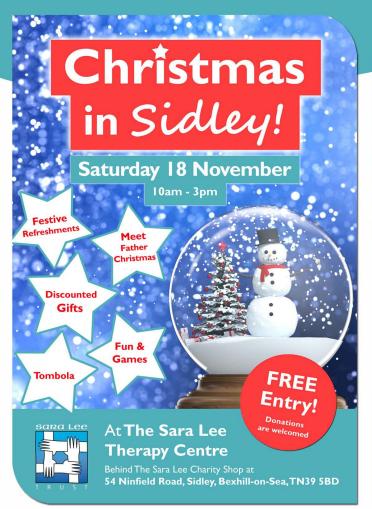
